

UK Research Councils' Funding Settlement

Just before Christmas the UK government announced the science and research budget for 2011/12 to 2014/15- which comes it at around £11.2billion. The ministerial statement available [here](#) breaks down the resource and capital allocation for capital by the various research councils, HEFCE, National Academies, and the UK space agencies. A more detailed [report](#) entitled 'Investing in Science and Research' is available from the Department of Business, Innovation and Skills . [THE](#) notes that no research council will see its resource budget cut by more than an average of 2.6 per cent compared with 2011-2012; although capital budgets have taken a sharper hit; 77 per cent for the Medical Research Council and 50 per cent for The Biological Sciences Research Council.
