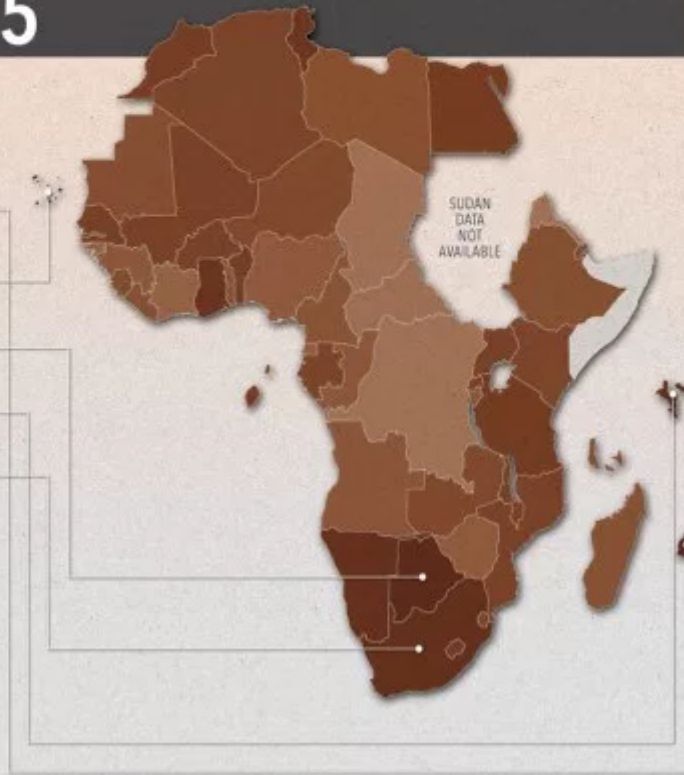


AFRICA FROM TOP TO BOTTOM

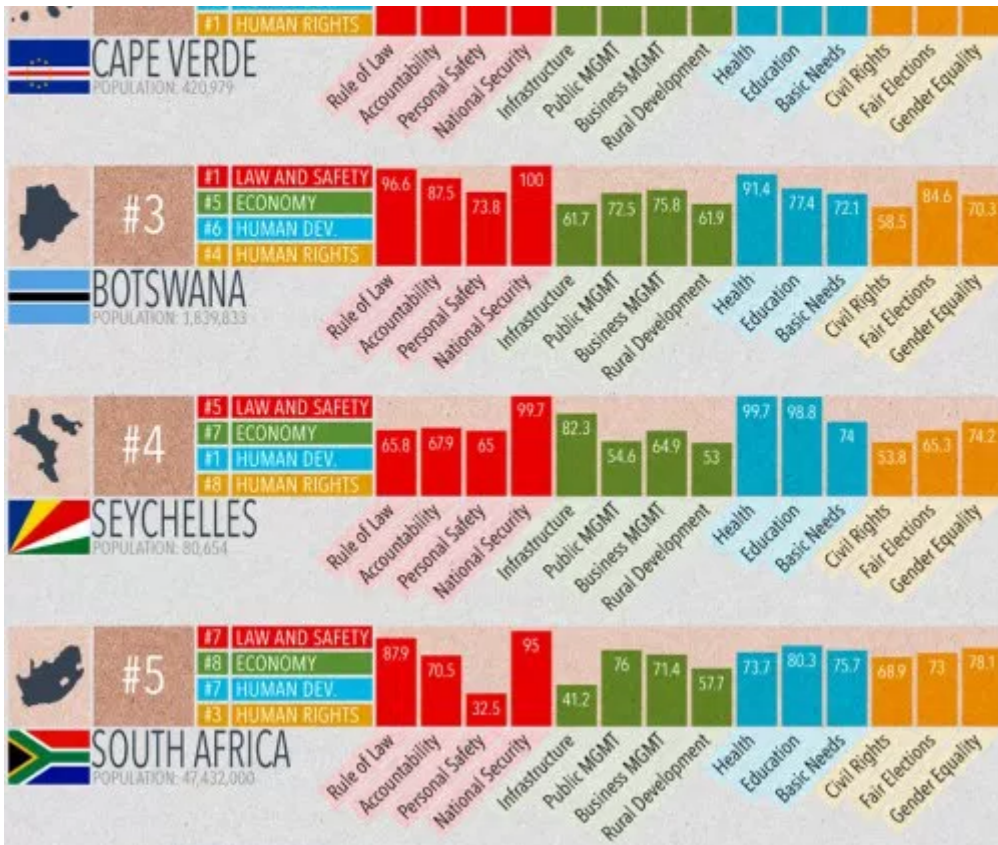

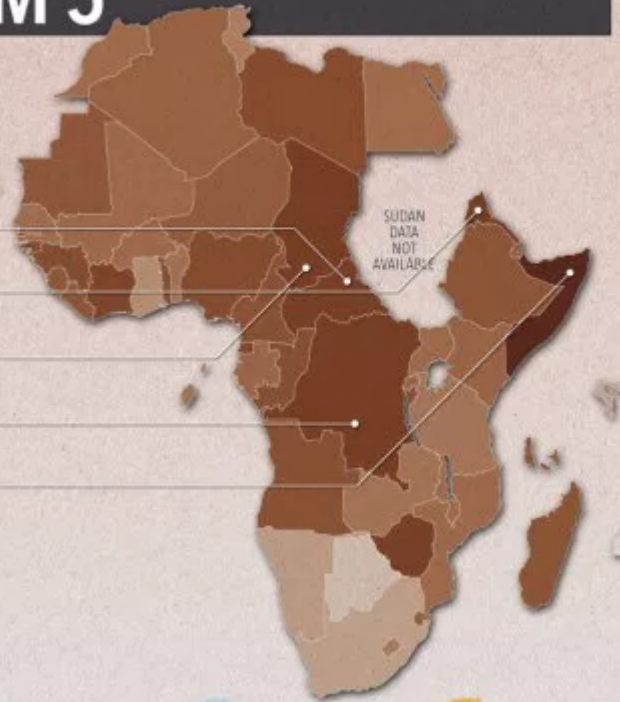

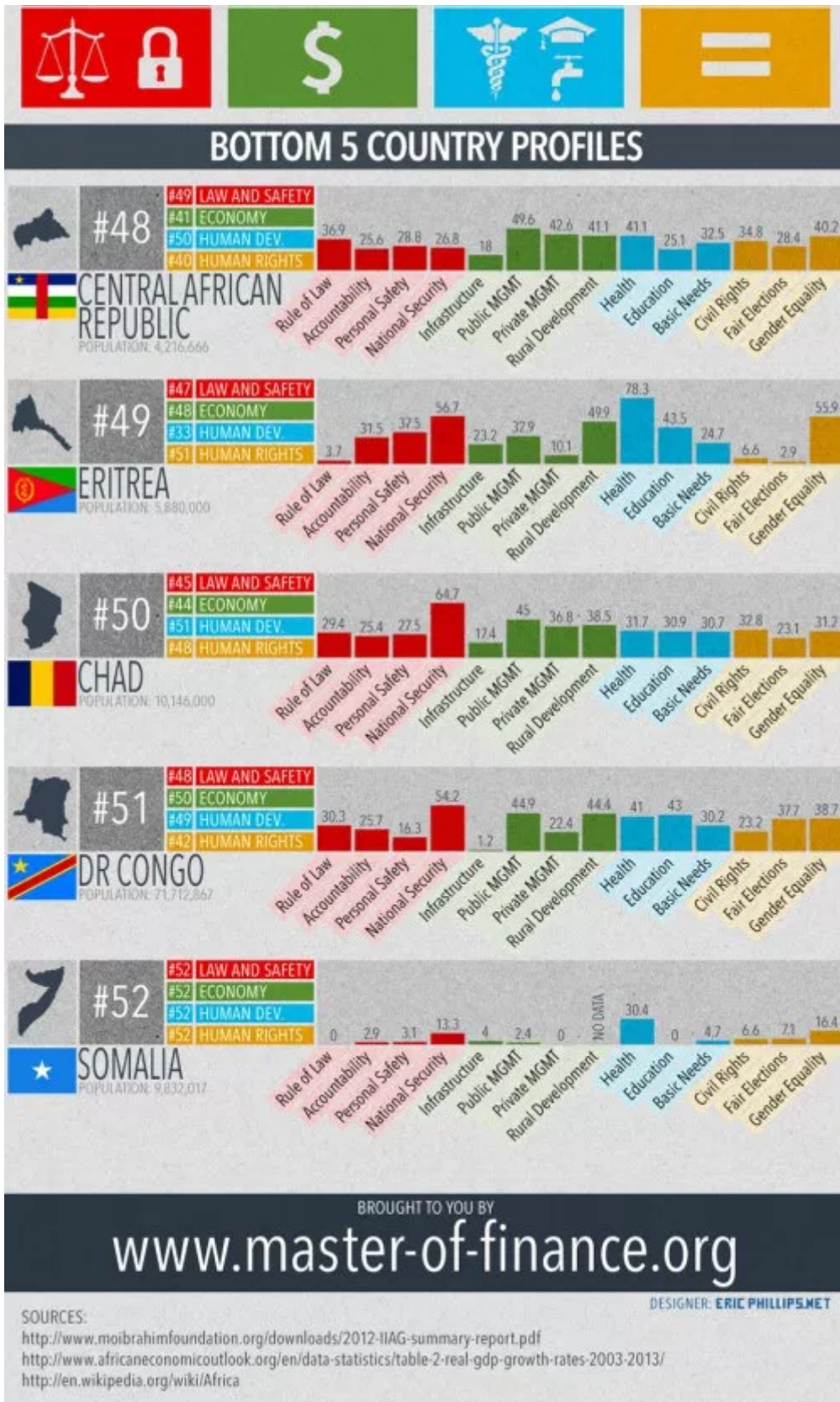
